Career Pathways- 9th and 10th grade

Incoming freshmen choose one of our high-demand, career pathways.

Agri-Business – Learn modern agriculture, technology and Ag-business
Audio Video Technology – Learn studio production, video editing, lighting, and directing
Construction – Learn skills in woodworking, carpentry, plumbing, and masonry
Aviation – Explore aviation through maintenance, pilot training and drones
Drafting & Design – Learn architectural design, computer drawing, and 3D printing
Engineering – Explore civil, mechanical and industrial engineering
Graphic Design- Learn graphic design, multimedia art, and print production
Health Informatics – Learn the business side of healthcare records, insurance, and billing
Healthcare Science – Learn about patient care, nursing, nurse aide and health
Information Technology – Learn to program, create websites and network computers
Marketing / Entrepreneurship – Learn about business ownership and brand management
Mechatronics – Learn about electrical systems, solving programs and basic programming
