### PATHWAY OVERVIEW

The Agribusiness Management and Leadership course provides students real-world experience in Georgia's largest industry-- agriculture. Students in the Agribusiness program learn the principles and practices of agribusiness management and leadership including business management, agricultural economics, agriculture technology and science, marketing trends, and agricultural law.

Students in the Agribusiness pathway are also responsible for the Commodore Garden, a school-sponsored enterprise that provides fresh fruits and vegetables as well as health and wellness information to the local community.
